



Black Rock Primary School Policy Guide

Rationale:

- Black Rock Primary School encourages the active involvement of parents and guardians in the functioning of the school.

Aims:

- To enhance the environment, strength and success of the school, through the voluntary contribution of parents and guardians.

Implementation:

1. Parents and guardians are elected to the School Council and/or sub-committees.
2. The Class Parent Representative Scheme and Gardening work actively for the benefit of the students of the school. Membership of these groups offers friendship and social involvement for all parents and guardians. The fundraising and voluntary work provide specific school facilities, equipment and services.
3. All parents and guardians are encouraged to participate in the development of school policies, the raising and allocation of funds and providing assistance with many school activities and programs. Many programs rely on the participation, assistance and support of parents and guardians.
4. Throughout the school year parents and guardians are given the opportunity to participate in Parent Education Programs Information Sessions, forums/meetings. Parent/Teacher conferences and decision-making through surveys.
