

# CHELTENHAM ROAD



Retain & protect existing vegetation around perimeter of school grounds

Universal access Adventure/Fitness track around oval area. (Approximate alignment - subject to detail design to ensure no loss or damage to existing vegetation and compliance with access standards)

Running track line markings (will not be a competition surface). Surface is the same as playing fields

New sports surface for cricket, soccer and Auskick

Catchment along side of synthetic surface for harvest of drainage into sub-surface tanks. Subject to further engineering assessment, design and costing

Net behind goals. Goal post location to be confirmed.

Add several new logs to create space for outdoor classroom

Remove existing containers. Extend existing shed to house sports equipment, maintenance, event materials and archives.

REFER TO MP-01

New concrete paths to provide access to oval and play equipment

Four trees to be planted in tree bays and raised garden beds to be added alongside classrooms as part of an on-going garden club project. Ramp to classroom to be removed.

CHANGE FACILITIES AND FIRST AID ROOM

STADIUM

Form a larger mound than the one existing to create an amphitheatre from which to spectate events on the oval

Existing bike shed to be relocated

Proposed change facilities to include:  
 - referee room/ office  
 - storage for sports equipment  
 - two unisex change rooms & toilet  
 - first aid room

Add wayfinding signage to assist visitors

Existing gates for maintenance and emergency vehicle access

Moveable soccer goals

Note: Where possible, line mark to avoid conflict between goal areas and sporting code lines

Aussie rules football goal posts location to be confirmed. To be outside soccer pitch boundary.

Locate long jump in this area

Plant new screening vegetation

Sports practice space

Retain & protect existing significant tea tree in the nature play zone

Universal access Adventure/Fitness track around oval area. (Approximate alignment - subject to detail design to ensure no loss or damage to existing vegetation and compliance with access standards)

New playground - relocate existing equipment where possible (equipment shown is indicative only)

Plant single trunked trees to ensure clear visibility through area
